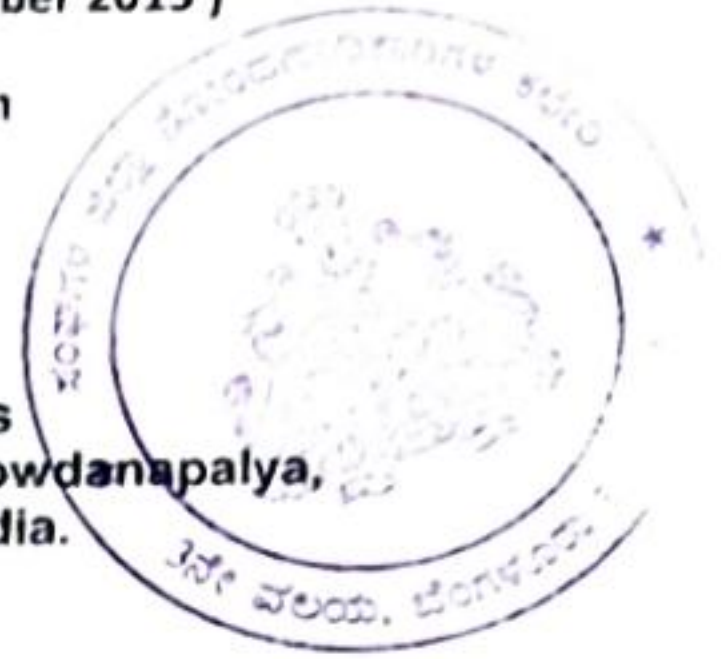

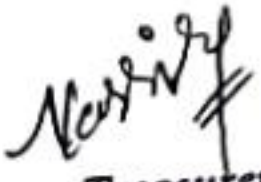

3. **Aims, objects, functions and duties:**

The aims and objects for which the Federation is established are:-

- (a) To promote Pencak Silat Activities in the Country & to promote moral and cultural education of the youth of the nation for the development of character, good health and good citizenship.
- (b) To develop, promote, regulate, organise and control the game of Pencak Silat with the aim to secure medals by the athletes at the highest level of competitions in India or abroad.
- (c) To coordinate and encourage all activities in connection with Pencak Silat in India and abroad.
- (d) To seek affiliation with and recognition by the competent regional, national, and international bodies.
- (e) To grant affiliation to the States and Union Territories in the Country & to keep proper control of the affiliated state units
- (f) To hold National Championships for men & women, boys and girls at various level in the country.
- (g) To participate in the International and the other recognized tournaments in the country or overseas, which will be organized under the banner of India/Asian / South Asian /International Pencak Silat Federation.
- (h) To make selections of Indian team (players, officials, coaches and managers) participating in the World Championships, Asian Games and Asian Championship and such other International Championships/ tournaments & to organise and hold coaching and training camps for players and refresher courses for referees and coaches for promotion of the game.
- (i) To raise funds for the Indian Pencak Silat Federation.
- (j) To grant permission to affiliated state units to organize Pencak Silat competitions in the country.
- (k) To foster a spirit of comradeship amongst the recognized units.
- (l) To lay down rules and regulations for affiliation of members with the Federation and for their proper functioning.

- (m) To levy affiliation and other fees from its members for the proper discharge of its functions.
- (n) To coordinate, assist and guide the activities and functioning of member organisations and through them other Pencak Silat bodies under their jurisdiction.
- (o) To take disciplinary action against the members, their officials and office bearers for misbehaviour or any other undesirable activity bringing discredit to the Federation and Pencak Silat sport.
- (p) To act as a channel of communication between the Pencak Silat Association of States/ UTs/ Units and the Government of India for financial or other assistance, where necessary.
- (q) To hear appeals from its members, players, clubs, technical and other officials, coaches.
- (r) To collect, receive and acquire grants, funds, donations, contributions, trophies, awards and other properties, movable and immovable on behalf of the Association.
- (s) To invite teams / individuals and officials to the country and to organise international meets/championships, impart training and conduct tours within the country.
- (t) To arrange representation of the Association in international bodies, Asian bodies and in such other bodies as is considered necessary, and their meetings.
- (u) To resist in the realm of sports all pressures of any kind, whether of a political, racial, religious or economic nature.
- (v) To take steps for prevention of various unethical practices including doping among the athletes for Pencak Silat sport.
- (w) To generally do all such other acts as may be desirable or necessary to preserve and / or augment the interest/cause of the game/ Federation.

2 (a) **Secretariat & Correspondence - address-**

Definitions:-

Indian Pencak Silat Federation hereby refereed as a National Sports Federation shall be governed by its Memorandum/Bye-Laws/ Rules & Regulations framed thereunder & shall follow all the rules & regulations of PERSILAT.

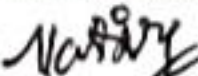
The following terms shall, unless the context requires otherwise, having meanings as defined below:-

3. **Rules and Regulations:**

Definitions and Explanations, unless otherwise indicated by the context:

- (a) The 'Federation' means the ' Indian Pencak Silat Federation'.
- (b) "Member" means a member unit of the " Indian Pencak Silat Federation " i.e. Associations of States / UTs.
- (c) 'Associate members' means a member unit of the Indian Pencak Silat Federation other than States / UTs.
- (d) The 'General Body' means and consisting of equal number of representatives from each of affiliate units of Indian Pencak Silat Federation and such other *ex officio* members as per this constitution and the constitution of International Pencak Silat Federation, as applicable.
- (e) 'Constitution' means the Constitution of the Indian Pencak Silat Federation.
- (f) 'The Executive Committee' means the Executive Committee of the ' Indian Pencak Silat Federation ' constituted under the rules and regulations herein contained to whom the management of the affairs of the Federation is entrusted.
- (g) 'Rules and Regulations' mean Rules and Regulations framed by the Federation under the Constitution for the conduct of the affairs of the Federation.
- (h) 'Sportsperson of Outstanding Merit (SOM)' means an individual designated as sportsperson of outstanding merit under the Sportspersons of Outstanding Merit Rules under National Sports Governance (National Sports Bodies) Rules, 2025
- (i) 'Board' means the National Sports Board established under sub-section (1) of section 5 of the National Sports Governance Act, 2025

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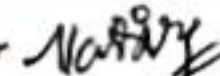

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- (j) 'Election Rules' means the Election Rules in Schedule II of the National Sports Governance (National Sports Bodies) Rules, 2025 as applicable to the Federation as a National Sports Body.
- (k) 'Tribunal' means the National Sports Tribunal constituted under sub-section (1) of section 17 of the National Sports Governance Act, 2025

4. **Federation Year:**

The official year, including financial year, of the Association shall be from 1st April to 31st March of the following year.

5. **Affiliation / Membership:**

The membership of the Association shall be open to:-

- (a). Application for affiliation from an organization shall be submitted to the Secretary General along with a list of its office bearers for the current year along with the proposed detail of activities. In case there is no above mentioned formalities listed at the time of application by the said unit applying for affiliation. The application cannot be accepted.
- (b). The Honorary Secretary General shall place before the Affiliation Committee such applications for disposal. The Affiliation Committee have full right to may reject any application for affiliation without mentioning any reason in any case.
- (c). It is essential that every *existing member State / UTs affiliated with IPSF* as well as their members i.e. District Pencak Silat Associations affiliated must comply with the statutory requirements of the National Sports Governance Act, 2025 and the rules framed thereunder in the same manner as the IPSF follows the same. All affiliated State / UT members of IPSF shall get them registered with the National Sports Board in the manner as specified by it. IPSF shall facilitate the registration of each of its affiliate units with the National Sports Board.
- (d). Any new body seeking membership of IPSF, Conditional membership can be given with the recommendations of Affiliation committee, subject to 3 years audit report(s), Bank account(s), Sports activity(ies), and other necessary statutory and business documents are submitted. No voting rights will be granted to the new body, without the satisfactory track-record for last 3 years, is examined to find the same, in order.

6. **Membership & Membership Fees:**

(I). **Admission Fee and Annual Renewal Fee**

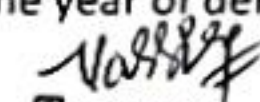
- (a) The fee for admission as well as the annual renewal fee payable to the Federation, shall be as follows:-

For Pencak Silat Associations of States or UT's, the admission fee (New member registration / affiliation) for membership shall be INR. 20,000/- one-time and the annual renewal fee shall be INR 10,000/- Whether the state unit or Union Territory is an Affiliated or Provisional or have Observer status .

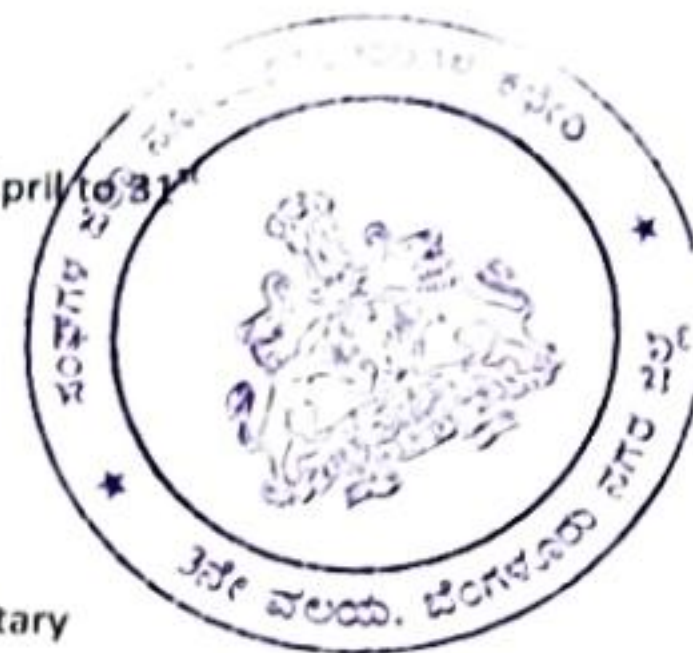
- (b) These units will be recognized for the purpose of participation of their state Athlete's, to give them a chance to promote & develop Pencak Silat in their respective states and Grant of recognition from their state Government/ State Olympic Associations only. They will not be entitled to attend meetings of the Federation. Once they will fulfil the criteria of the Federation, then they will be eligible as a Full affiliated member of the IPSF

Defaulters shall be served a notice of dues by the Secretary general/Treasurer of the federation for payment of the annual renewal fee along with the penalty of INR.500/- each month, in the year of default. Defaulters will however be entitled

for restoration of rights and privileges only on payment of arrears/ annual renewal fee along with the applicable penalty fee.

6 (II). State / UT Pencak Silat Association's

- (a). It shall be binding on all the State/Union Territory Pencak Silat Association's affiliated with the Federation to forward their latest Constitution Copy along with amendments, whenever made, Annual report and audited statement of accounts every year. The affiliated units shall also conduct their elections as and when due (i.e) once in 4 years or in special circumstances, as and when directed by the Federation. The non-compliance of these requirements may result in dis-affiliation of the defaulting units by the General Council of the Association on the recommendations of the Executive Committee. If the due elections are not held in time, affiliation will be suspended.
- (b). All affiliated units shall intimate the dates and venues of the Annual General Meeting of their respective Associations to the Federation well in advance to depute an observer from IPSF, as and when considered necessary to attend such meeting and submit a report to the IPSF for conformation accordingly.
- (c). The member Associations must be registered as a distinct entity under an appropriate Act or law in their respective jurisdiction and should be registered with the Board in such manner, as prescribed under the National Sports Governance (National Sports Bodies) Rules, 2025.

6 (III). DEFAULTERS & DIS-AFFILIATION:-

- (a). A member failing to pay the membership fee as well as other dues, if any, due to federation before the 30th March every year shall be treated as defaulter and such defaulter shall neither be allowed to the membership of the General Assembly, Executive Council nor Committees of the Federation. But the member shall be allowed to participate in the championships conducted under the banner of the Indian Pencak Silat Federation. A defaulter will however be entitled for restoration of rights and privileges only on payment of the arrears of membership fee's together with a penalty amounting to 20% of the annual renewal fee , whichever is more, provided the executive committee in its meeting approves the same and the restoration is communicated to the defaulter accordingly.
- (b). If the renewal membership fee's and are not paid on or before the last day of the following year the defaulter will automatically cease to be a member of the Federation.

6 (IV). RE-AFFILIATION:-

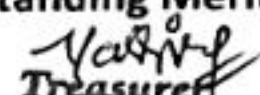
- (a) A member, who ceases to be a member of the Federation either by forfeiture of membership or otherwise shall in no circumstances be eligible for re-affiliation unless all its arrears of membership fee or other dues if any to the Federation, are cleared. The ceased member has to write application for re-affiliation to the Chairman, Affiliation Committee along with the Pending Fee's etc for the consideration, But the affiliation committee have full right to accept or reject the application without giving any reasons.

7. **GENERAL BODY:**

The General Body of the Federation shall have the following with voting rights:-

- (a) Four Sportsperson of Outstanding Merit (2 male and 2 female) as nominated by the Athletes Commission of the Federation in accordance with the manner provided under the Sportspersons of Outstanding Merit Rules;

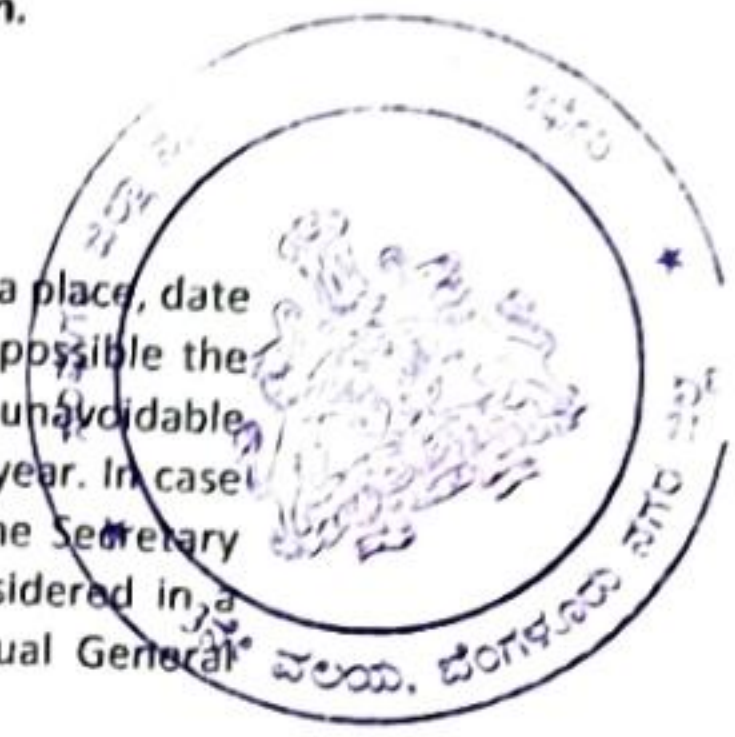

- (b) Two representatives of each State level affiliate unit of the federation registered with the National Sports Board, who must either be the President and Secretary General, or nominee members of the Executive Committee duly approved by the President.
- (c) Any Indian member / office bearer of the International Pencak Silat Federation.

8. **ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:**

- (a). The Annual General Meeting of the assembly shall be held twice every year at a place, date & time to be decided upon by the President / Secretary General. As far as possible the meeting shall be held by rotation at different places. But in case due to unavoidable reason, the meeting is not held twice every year, it can take place once in a year. In case the Annual General Meeting is not held in the year, the Annual Report of the Secretary General and the audited Statement of Accounts for that year may be considered in a meeting of the Executive Council, which can be later ratified in the Annual General Meeting.
- (b). In case the President is not available due to resignation, removal or death, the meeting will be convened with the consent of Senior Vice President.



8 (II). **The agenda of the Annual General Meeting shall also include:**

- (a). Confirmation of the minutes of the previous Annual General Meeting and of the Special General Meeting; if any.
- (b). Consideration and adoption of the Secretary General's annual report on the working & activities of the Federation.
- (c). Consideration and passing of the Audited Statement of Accounts of the year and the Budget for the next year to be submitted by the Treasurer.
- (d). Appointment of Auditors and fixing their remuneration.
- (e). Election of the Executive Council, Office Bearers (if due) and committees.
- (f). Consideration of the Annual Calendar for the Current or Next Financial Year.
- (g). Amendment(s) to the constitution (if any).
- (h). Any other business of which due notice has been given. i) Any matter affecting the welfare of the Federation which the President may bring or allow to be brought before it. This will include discussion about developmental activities and analysis of programmes and policies of the Federation. President can call meeting on telephonic message too.

NOTE: The Annual Report, Audited Statement of Accounts and all other relevant papers shall be circulated to the members before the meeting.

8 (III). **SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING:-**

Special General Meetings may be summoned at any time by the President at his discretion and shall be convened by the Secretary General. If 20 member units want any serious matter(s) concerning the development of Pencak Silat to be discussed. President may call such a meeting within 30 days, provided 20 member units send a representations to President / Secretary General in writing.

8 (IV). **EMERGENT MEETING:-**

- (a). Notwithstanding anything in the constitution, an Emergent Meeting of the assembly may be convened by the Secretary General in consultation with the President on urgent / Specific matters.

8 (V). **NOTICES AND QUORUM FOR MEETINGS:-**

8 (VI).Meeting Notice Period Quorum

- (a). Annual General Meeting 15 clear days One-third of the (Annual Meeting of the Representatives Assembly) entitled to vote or
- (b). 15 representatives whichever is less. ii) Special General Meeting 10 clear days 15 representatives.
- (c). Emergent Meeting 10 clear days 15 representatives (By Tel / Email) iv) Executive Council Meeting 10 clear days 7 representatives v) Emergent Executive Council Meeting 7 clear days 7 representatives vi) Committee Meetings 7 clear days 3 representatives

NOTE: Word 'Clear' means from the date of posting by speed post or Courier/ by telephone / by email. The Notice can be sent either by post or by email or through Official Whatsapp only. Besides the above, meeting may be convened by the Secretary General during any National Championships at a very short notice with the Consent of the majority of the members present at such meetings, can only discuss matter relating to the particular Championships or related matter.

On any issue of very urgent nature and under special circumstances when a meeting of the Executive Council cannot be convened, the Secretary General may obtain the approval of the members of the council by circulation and act accordingly, provided that majority of members favour the proposal so circulated. But such cases must be placed at the next meeting of the council for formal rectification and records.

9. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The composition of the Executive Committee shall be as under:

- i President
- ii Senior Vice President
- iii Vice Presidents – 2 (1 Reserved for Woman)
- iv Secretary General
- v Treasurer
- vi Joint Secretary - 2 (1 Reserved for Woman)
- vii Executive Members - 6 (at least two, one male and one female, shall be sportspersons of outstanding merit ; two, one male and one female, shall be from the Athletes Committee to be elected from amongst themselves)
- viii Member Ex-officio – 1 (Indian member / office bearer of the International Pencak Silat Federation)

10. ELECTIONS:

- (a) The Election to the Executive Committee shall be conducted in accordance with the applicable Election Rules/National Sports Bodies Rules, 2025 framed under the National Sports Governance Act, 2025.
- (b) Elections shall be held once in four years at the Annual General Meeting (Meeting of the Assembly) to elect the Executive Council and other committees from amongst the representatives of the members.
- (C) Eligibility

A person shall not be qualified to contest for election or seek nomination to, the Executive Committee, unless—

(a) such person is a citizen of India who has attained at least twenty-five years of age;

(b) the nomination of such person is duly proposed and seconded by a voting member of the General Body;

(c) such person is not declared to be of unsound mind;

(d) such person complies with the International Charters and Statutes and bye-laws relating to age and term of the Executive Committee:

Provided that such person shall not be more than seventy years of age on the last date of nomination for election: 6

Provided further that any person, aged between seventy and seventy-five years, may contest elections or seek nominations, if permitted by the International Charters and Statutes and the bye-laws and in case such person is elected, he shall serve for a full term;

(e) such person, if he is a government servant, has necessary approvals from the Government, as applicable:

Provided that a person shall not be qualified to contest for election or seek nomination to, the posts of the President or the Secretary General or the Treasurer, unless such person is a sportsperson of outstanding merit or has previously served as a member for at least one full term in the Executive Committee of the National Sports Body or as the President, or the Secretary General or the Treasurer in its affiliate unit:

Provided further that a person may continuously hold the position of either the President or the Secretary General or the Treasurer, as the case may be, for up to three consecutive terms separately, or in combination thereof and shall be eligible for election to such posts or to the Executive Committee after a mandatory cooling off period of one term.

11. Disqualifications. — (1) A person shall be disqualified from being a member of the General Body, or of any committee of the Federation, and shall not be eligible for contesting for election to the Executive Committee or the Athletes Committee, if such person is-

- (a) declared insolvent under applicable law; or
- (b) subject to a conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction in India for an offence, followed by a sentence of imprisonment; or
- (c) subject to a ban from holding any such position by an order of the Ethics Committee of such National Sports Body:

Provided that the disqualification in respect of -

- (i) clause (a) shall be for the period of insolvency as applicable;
- (ii) clause (b) shall be for a period of one full term of the Executive Committee after the completion of such sentence; and
- (iii) clause (c) shall be for the duration of such ban.

(2) a person shall be disqualified from -

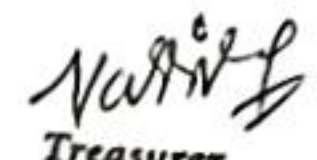
- (a) being a member of the General Body or of any committee of the Federation, or shall not be eligible for contesting elections to the Executive Committee or the Athletes Committee, if such person is a member of any other National Sports Body/ National Sports Federation other than the National Olympic Committee; and
- (b) being a member of the General Body or of any committee of the Federation, where such person has not completed the cooling off period of one term after having held the position of President, Secretary General or Treasurer in any other National Sports Body.

10. (1). VACANCIES:-

The office of a member of the council (including that of an office bearer) shall fall vacant-

- (a). If the Organization he represents ceases to be a member or he ceases to be a member of any member Organization.
- (b). If he/she resigns from his post by a notice in writing to the Secretary General and his resignation is accepted by the Executive Council (in the case of the Secretary General the notice of the resignation shall be addressed to the President). The Executive Council shall have power to fill up vacancy so caused by co- option from among the representatives to the assembly and that will remain good until the next election.

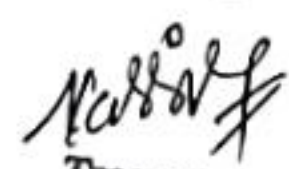

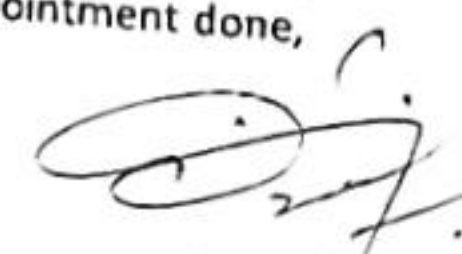
All those Units, who do not fall in any of the above category due to non-Compliance of National Sports Governance Act, 2025 and non-fulfillment of obligation laid down under the IPSF Constitution, can attend the meetings with the permission of the President, but without right to Vote (As observers).



- (a). The existing member State / UTs shall secure at least 50% of their District Pencak Silat Association as affiliated members within six months failing which their membership may be reviewed.
- (b). Any affiliated unit of the federation which fails to conduct its election will not be eligible to vote, nominated members of that unit can attend the meeting but without a right to vote.
- (c). IPSF declares disaffiliation of its members from state/UT's, if the elections are not held once in 4 years OR not informed about the elections to IPSF in advance OR IPSF Observer's report regarding the Elections held, not reported immediately OR elections done for any other parallel body other than to the State body affiliated to IPSF.
- (d). Other Departmental / Educational / Industrial organisations having all India character, will be considered / admitted as Associate member without voting rights.
- (e). Each Permanent Member State/ Union Territory shall intimate the name(s) of their representative(s) mentioned in sub-clauses (2). Latest by **Day-1 of Election process**; and such intimation shall be addressed to the President / Secretary General of IPSF on their letter head duly signed by President / General Secretary of that member unit, so as to reach him on or before the aforesaid date; any change in the name of any authorized representative after **Day-1** or any intimation received thereafter shall be permitted only with the approval of the President of IPSF.
- (f). The President / Secretary General of IPSF shall prepare the list of the authorized representatives of the Member States/Union Territories in **Form 1**, and circulate a copy of the list so prepared by him to all Member States/Union Territories, latest by **Day - 2**, by display, on the website of IPSF.
- (g). The President / Secretary General shall also furnish a duly authenticated copy of the list mentioned in sub-clause (5) to the Returning Officer as soon as his appointment done, by the President of IPSF.

12. Bank Accounts of the Association :

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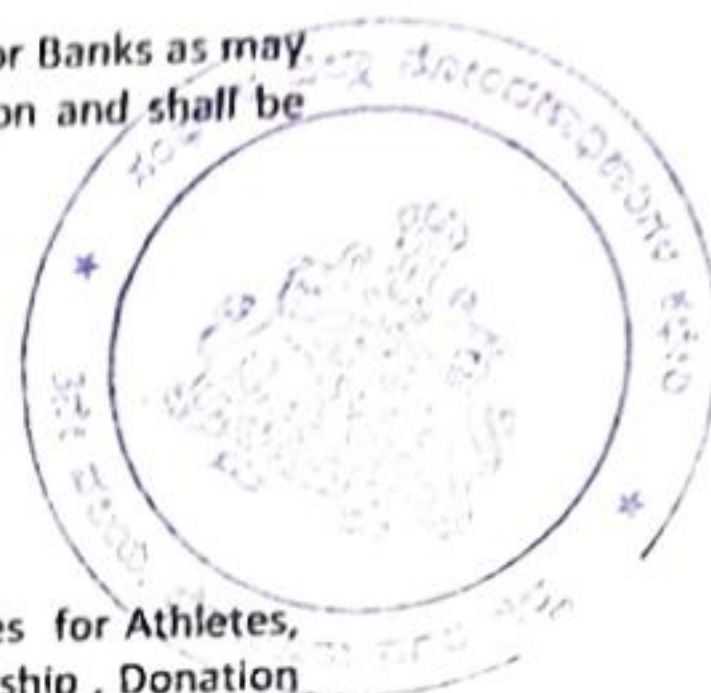
(I). Bank Account Operation

An account shall be maintained in such scheduled or Nationalized Bank or Banks as may be approved by the Executive Committee in the name of the Federation and shall be jointly operated upon by any two of the following office-bearers:-

1. President.
2. Secretary General.
3. Treasurer.

(II) Source of Income

The source of income for IPSF shall consists of one time registration fees for Athletes, Coaches and Referees, Grant-in-Aid from the SAI/Govt of India, Sponsorship , Donation from members or Outsiders, Interest from Bank etc.

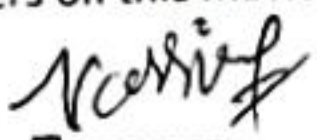


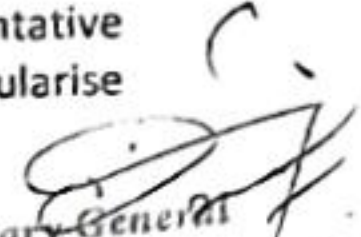
13. POWERS, FUNCTIONS & DUTIES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

(A) General Council:-

- (i) To formulate and enforce the policy of the Federation.
- (ii) To carry into effect the aims and objects of the Federation.
- (iii) To hold election of office-bearers, the Executive Committee every Four years in accordance with the provisions of this constitution.
- (iv) To admit to membership of any organisation eligible under the Constitution
- (v) To hold and control the funds and other properties of the Association.
- (vi) To consider the annual report of the Secretary General, audited statement of accounts and budget estimates of the Federation.
- (vii) To appoint Commission, commissions as and when necessary and implement their decisions.
- (viii) To be the official organisation in complete and sole charge of Pencak Silat matters in the country.
- (ix) In cooperation with the Pencak Silat Association of States/UTs to guard and enforce amateur rules.
- (x) To call regular and special meetings of the Council.
- (xi) To disaffiliate or take any suitable action against any Units & members for indiscipline, misbehaviour or any undesirable activity, violation of Constitution, bye-laws, rules or directives of the Council or Executive Committee issued from time to time, for not functioning properly or for not functioning at all, on the Executive Committee's recommendations or *sumo moto* and appoint ad-hoc Committee to discharge the functions of the Association of States/ UTs till the formation of new representative Association in place of Ad-hoc committee. Council will regularise President's orders on this matter, if any.

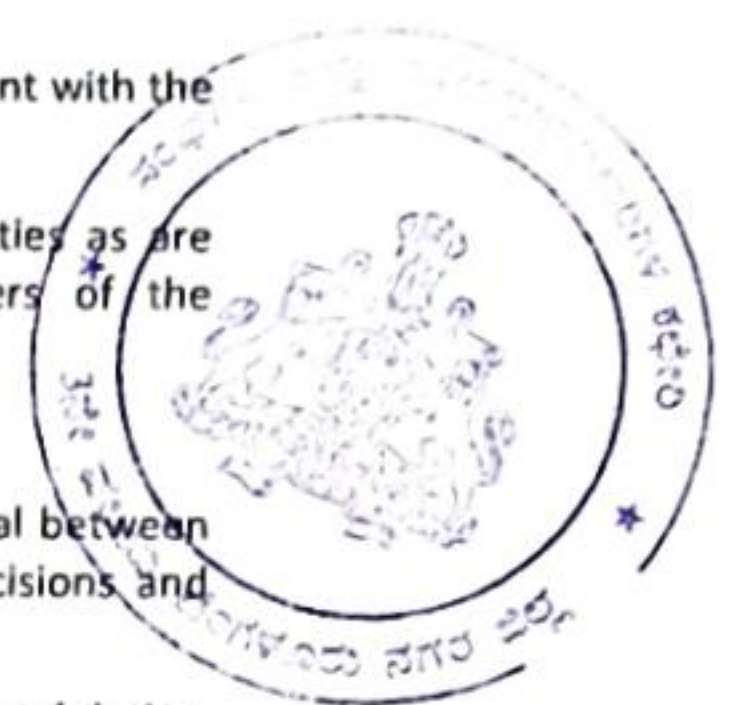

- (xii) To take disciplinary action against any State/Union Territory Pencak Silat Association for misbehaviour or any other undesirable activity bringing discredit to the country or to the Indian Pencak Silat Federation. Council will regularise President's orders on this matter, if any.
- (xiii) To have power to frame bye-laws and rules which are consistent with the constitution.
- (xiv) To exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as are incidental and relate to the purpose, object and powers of the Association.

(B) **Executive Committee:**

- (i) To conduct the business of the Association during the interval between meetings of the General Council and duly report all its decisions and actions to the General Council for its approval.
- (ii) To appoint special/ad-hoc committee(s) for specific functions and duties, as and when necessary for smooth functioning of the Association and/or its affiliated units in their States/ UTs. The Committee shall also frame necessary rules and regulations/terms of reference for such committees.
- (iii) To determine the number of competitors, managers, coaches etc. to be selected for participation in international sports competitions and/or foreign tours under the aegis of the IPSF.
- (iv) Under the patronage and guidance of the I.O.A. to be responsible for proper supervision of Indian teams for the Asian Games , Asian Indoor Games, SAF Games etc. during the period of the Games and their trips to and from the Games.
- (v) To initiate and recommend to the General Council, schemes for promotion and development of Pencak Silat in the country & special reference to those that are not developed or in areas that are underdeveloped.
- (vi) To consider the annual report prepared by the Secretary General and audited statement of accounts prepared by the Treasurer for submission of their recommendations to the General Council.
- (vii) To exercise the authority of the Association, in discharging the functions of the Council according to the rules and regulations.
- (viii) To take disciplinary action against any member, player, official etc. for the misconduct or any undesirable activities bringing discredit to the Association or its affiliates or their office-bearers and place the matter before the General Council, if found necessary. EC will regularise President's orders on this matter issued, if any.
- (ix) To receive protests, complaints, appeals and claims and dispose them off according to the rules.
- (x) To purchase or acquire any movable or immovable property or any interest therein for the benefit of the Federation.
- (xi) To fill-up vacancies in the Executive Committee and Sub-Committee during the session, if any.
- (xii) To exercise such other powers and to perform such other duties as may be assigned to it, by the Council.
- (xiii) To explain, define and interpret the provisions of this constitution, when dispute arises.



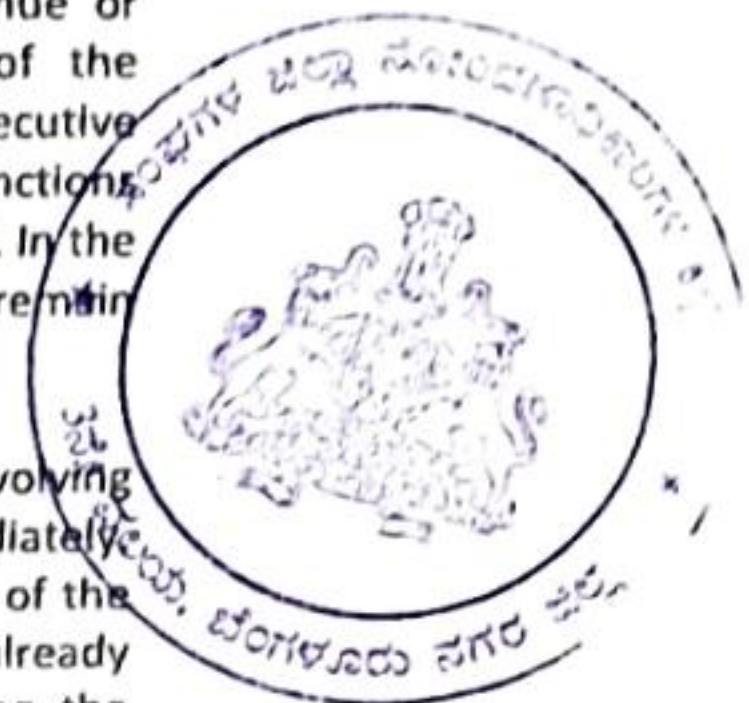

Note:

- (i) The Executive Committee shall have the authority to discontinue or suspend the affiliation of a member if the requirements of the Association are not satisfied or in the opinion of the Executive Committee, member is considered unfit to discharge its functions properly. This will however, be subject to an appeal to the Council. In the meantime the orders of the President/ Executive Committee will remain enforced.
- (ii) The decision of the President/ Executive Committee in all cases involving disciplinary action shall be final and shall come into force immediately. The fact that an appeal has been made will not stand in the way of the enforcement of the decision. If an appeal is accepted, the action already taken will cease to be operative. In case of the situation demanding, the President of the Association will have the authority to take disciplinary action against erring/ defaulting Associations, clubs, teams, players, officials, referees, organisers of championships/ tournaments or other members, without wasting any time. Such action will be communicated to the Executive Committee as early as possible. Disciplinary action comprises of suspension/ dissolution/ disaffiliation, cancellation of selection and/or withdrawal of certificates or recognition etc., as the case may be.

**(C). Other Committees:**

The President will constitute various Commissions, including their charter and composition. The Committees are advisory. Necessary recommendations will be made by them, subject-wise.

The list of the Sub Committees are as Under:

(xi). Dispute, Arbitration, Legal, & Grievance And redressal Committee	

(D). DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

The President may appoint a Disciplinary Committee from amongst the members of the Executive Committee along with the experts (minimum three members signatures are essential on such committee report), to deal with all matters pertaining to disputes/ disciplinary regulation. The committee will submit its report or findings to the President/ Secretary General. The decision taken by the President / Executive Committee will be ratified in the forthcoming General Council.

(E). DISCIPLINARY SANCTIONS:

The Indian Pencak Silat Federation member-units are liable to the following disciplinary sanctions:

- (i) Caution
- (ii) Warning
- (iii) Suspension for a specified period of time.
- (iv) Expulsion from the Indian Pencak Silat Federation.

Note:

1. Punishment/ Penalty shall not be imposed, without giving an opportunity to the Unit at fault.
2. Should an affiliated member/ Unit fails to present itself through its accredited office-bearer at the opportunity given/ Interrogation, Ex-parte action will be taken.
3. As a general rule, except in special circumstances duly appreciated, suspension shall be applied as a temporary measure.

(Disciplinary sanction by the President/ Executive Committee shall be ratified in the forthcoming General Council. Failing which it is treated void) .

(F). Athletes Committee:-

The IPSF shall constitute an Athletes Committee, The aim of the said committee shall give the representation to the Pencak Silat Athletes in the Administration with Voting rights.

(G). ETHICS Committee :-

The IPSF shall constitute an Ethics Committee in accordance with the provisions of National Sports Governance Act, 2025. All the matters in relation with the breach of ethics will be referred to the Ethics committee of Indian Pencak Silat Federation in relation to everyone connected with Pencak Silat for decision as per the provisions of the Code of Ethics of the Federation / applicable regulations.

(H) Dispute Resolution Committee,

The IPSF shall constitute a Dispute Resolution Committee, which shall –

(a) be in compliance with such guidelines as may be specified in the Charters and Statutes of the International Pencak Silat Federation (PRSILAT) / Pencak Silat Federation of Asia (PFA);

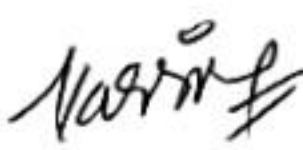

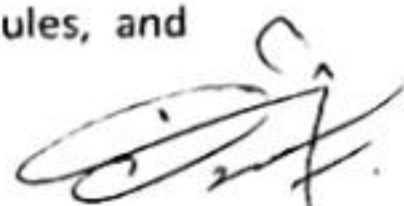
(b) in the absence of guidelines under clause (a), be guided by the model guidelines or regulations that may be specified by the National Sports Board from time to time.

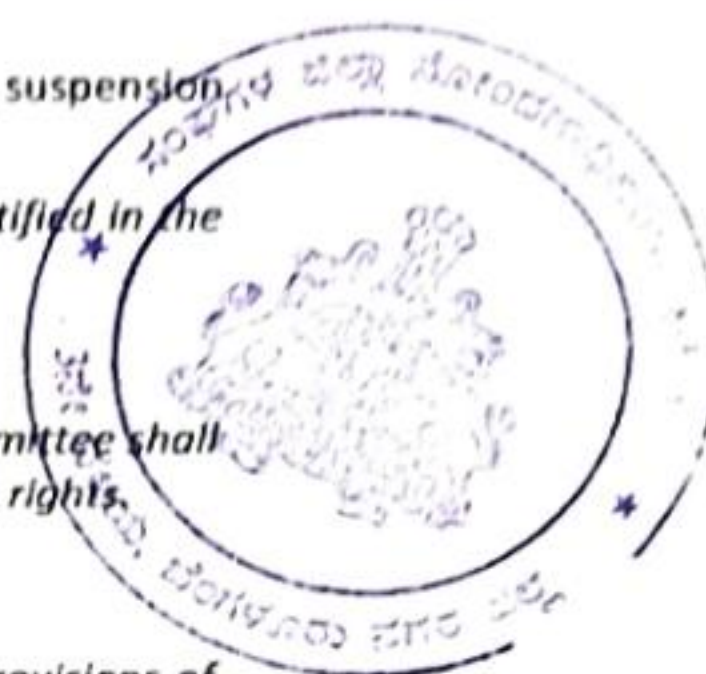
The Dispute Resolution Committee of IPSF shall have the following powers and responsibilities:

- (i) To hear and adjudicate disputes, complaints, and references arising among member units, officials, athletes, coaches, judges, or other stakeholders, provided such matters fall within the jurisdiction of the Federation.
- (ii) To ensure all proceedings strictly adhere to the principles of natural justice, ensuring all parties shall have a fair and neutral hearing.
- (iii) To establish and follow a transparent, time-bound and comprehensive procedure for the hearing, and disposal of all disputes.
- (iv) To facilitate, where appropriate and feasible, the amicable settlement or mediation of disputes without compromising organizational integrity, fairness, or the rules of the Federation.
- (v) To issue clear, written, and reasoned decisions / orders that explicitly detail the findings of fact, conclusions, and any binding directions.
- (vi) To recommend appropriate corrective, remedial, or disciplinary measures to the Federation when violations are established, in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations.
- (vii) To maintain strict confidentiality regarding all proceedings, deliberations, and records, except where disclosure is mandated by law or the official regulations of the Federation.
- (viii) To discharge any other functions incidental or ancillary to the effective resolution of disputes as entrusted to it under the Constitution, Rules, and Regulations of IPSF or as per the applicable laws.

14. **APPEAL:**

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Pencak Silat Association of States/ UTs affiliated to the Indian Pencak Silat Federation shall commit themselves to appeal only to the President/ Secretary General of Indian Pencak Silat Federation in the event of any difference, which may arise with regard to the functioning of the Pencak Silat Associations of States/ UTs within its laid down statutes and Rules and Regulations. Pencak Silat Association of States/ UTs are not allowed to appeal in any other jurisdiction.

15. **Un-sportsperson like behaviour and acts of violence:**

During the Nationals, Asian Championships, World Championships, Asian Games or any other international competitions, any unsportsmanlike behaviour on the part of a sportsman, official or coach which includes insulting, being not self-disciplined, negligent/not caring events' time-schedules, making undesirable gestures, abusing the decision of the judges/referees and provoking the opponents or spectators etc. in words or committing any act not in keeping with the propriety of sports shall be punished as follows:

- (i) Disqualification for the duration of the activity of that item of sports;

AND/ OR

- (ii) Disqualification for the entire duration of the competition;

AND/ OR

- (iii) Prohibition from participation in competitions for a specified period of time.

16. **RESIDUAL POWERS:**

In the event of a disagreement concerning the above Disciplinary Rules, the interpretation of these regulations shall fall within the competence of the Executive Committee of Indian Pencak Silat Federation, which shall be the final authority.

17. **Duties of the office-bearers:**

(a) **President:**

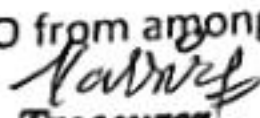
The President shall be the head of the Indian Pencak Silat Federation and shall preside over all meetings of the Council and the Executive Committee. He shall guide the Federation in all its activities in consultation with the Technical Director and DG/CEO. He shall exercise superintendence over office bearers and Members of Executive Committee in discharge of their duties. The President shall have the authority to depute Senior Vice-President of the Indian Pencak Silat Federation to exercise the power of President, in his absence.

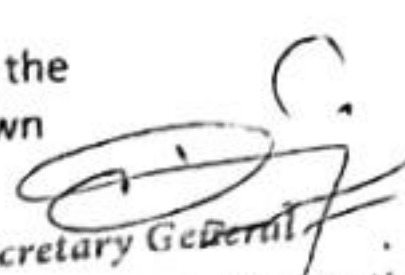
- (i) To implement the objectives of the Indian Pencak Silat Federation.
(ii) To ensure that the financial position of the Indian Pencak Silat Federation is sound.
(iii) The President is to ensure the conduct of various business meetings, as required under the Constitution, to be duly held.
(iv) In case of urgency, Emergent meetings may be summoned by the President at his discretion with lesser notice period prescribed.
(v) President & Secretary General shall appoint Chairman/ CEO/ Other such positions/ Associate Vice President(s), Associate Joint Secretary(s) & Associate Executive member(s) on nomination basis, so as to be a catalyst to enhance the effectiveness of the administrative-machinery. Their Charter/ Domain/ Responsibilities will be assigned specifically by the President/ Executive Committee, from time to time.

(b) **Senior Vice-President:**

In the absence of the President, Senior Vice-President present in the meeting will be the Chairman. In the event of prolonged absence, the President shall depute Senior Vice-President to take over the duties and responsibilities of the President. If the President and the Senior Vice-President is not available, the Council or the Executive Committee, as the case may be, shall elect its own Secretary General or CEO from amongst the members present.

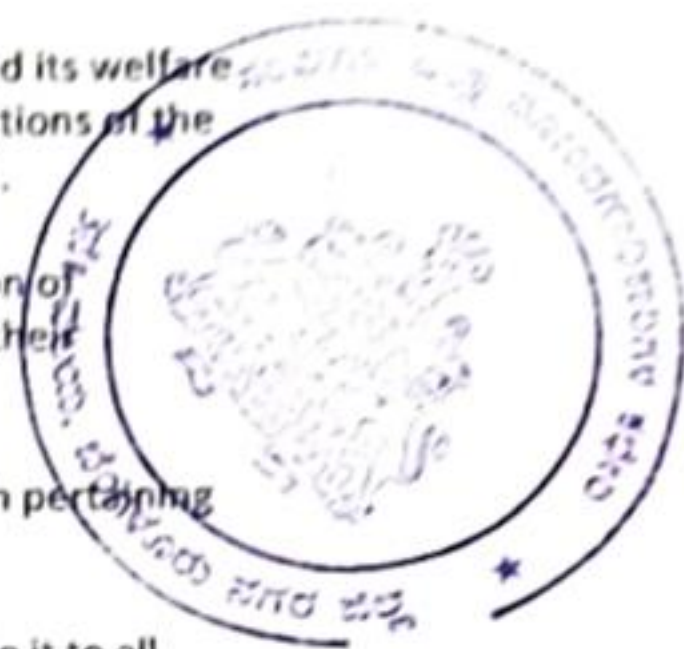
(C) Vice-Presidents:

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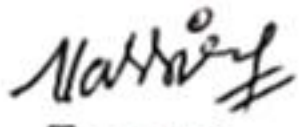
In the absence of the President / Senior Vice-President, with the collective consent of the Members of the Executive Committee, one of the Vice-Presidents shall preside over the meeting.

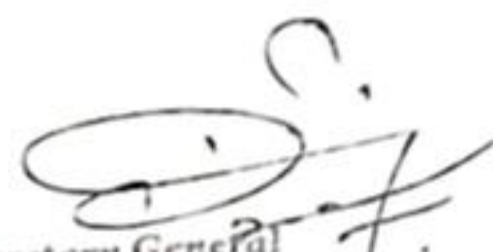
(d) Secretary General:

- (i) He will look after the day-to-day affairs of the Association and its welfare in accordance with the rules, regulations, bye-laws and directions of the President, the Executive Committee and the General Council.
- (ii) He shall be responsible to call for all meetings as per direction of President and prepare & compile agenda(s) and implement their decision(s).
- (iii) He shall carry all correspondence on behalf of the Federation pertaining to the functions within and outside the Federation.
- (iv) He shall record the minutes of all meetings and shall circulate it to all concerned (within 30 days). He shall ensure that all correspondence and documents connected with the business of the Federation, are properly kept and preserved.
- (v) He shall maintain proper stock book(s) of all properties of the Federation and conduct annual stock-verification of all such properties. To keep them upto-date.
- (vi) He shall prepare and submit the annual report to the Executive Committee/General Council in their respective meetings.
- (vii) He shall convene meetings of the Federation under the directions of the President/ Executive Committee.
- (viii) The Secretary General shall ensure that the accounts of the Federation have been properly maintained by the Treasurer & audited as per audit norms.
- (ix) To keep records of all competitions and tournaments, including those held under the aegis of the Indian Pencak Silat Federation.
- (x) He shall keep in custody and maintain in good order and condition all trophies, souvenirs and seals and all other furniture and properties of the Federation.
- (xi) He shall call for any papers and information from affiliated units/associated members and other office-bearers of the Association necessary for the disposal of any matter and perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the constitution, rules, regulations and bye-laws of the Federation.
- (xii) He shall grant registration to tournaments of all India level, and take steps incidental thereto, according to rules.
- (xiii) He will function generally under the direction of the President/ Executive Committee.
- (xiv) He may be allowed to keep an impress cash not exceeding Rs.50, 000/- per item, for defraying urgent expenses.

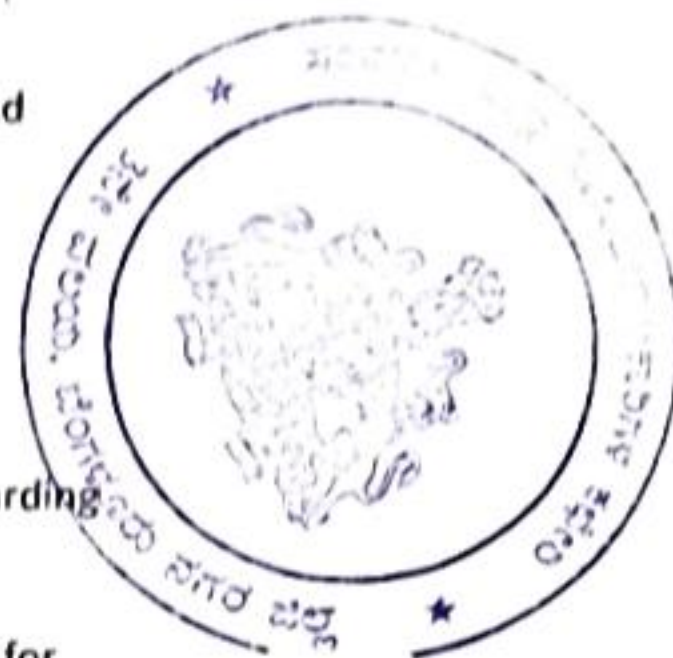

(e) **Treasurer:**

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- (i) He shall receive all moneys of the Federation and maintain proper accounts of the same and issue appropriate receipts.
- (ii) He shall be in-charge of all moneys, account-books, papers, vouchers and records including Cheque book pertaining to his office and shall submit an audited statement of accounts annually and/or otherwise, if necessary.
- (iii) He shall also maintain an inventory of the Federation's property and submit the same along with the accounts.
- (iv) He shall deposit all moneys as and when received in the Federation account with the approved Bank without unreasonable delay.
- (v) He will help the auditor in all possible ways in the auditing of the accounts and to explain to him such items, entries explanation regarding which he may be called for.
- (vi) He will send copies of his correspondence to the Secretary General for coordination.
- (vii) He shall prepare the budget estimate and shall present it, before the Executive Committee or the General Council, as the case may be.
- (viii) He may be allowed to keep an impress cash not exceeding Rs. 30,000/- per item for defraying urgent expenses. No other expenditure shall be made by the Treasurer, without the sanction of the President or Secretary General.



18. **Amendments to the Rules and Regulations:**

No amendment shall be made to these Rules and Regulations except at the AGM/ SGM and unless supported by two thirds of the members present and voted.

As a norm, all the proposed amendments must be presented to the Secretary General three weeks before such meeting and forwarded by him to every member Fourteen days before the meeting.

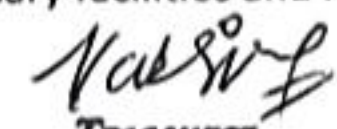

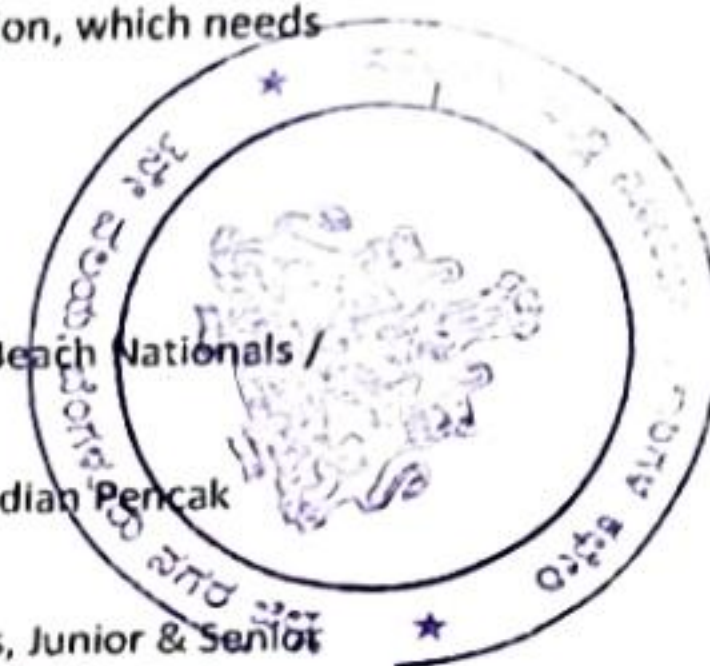

- vi). To make efforts to popularize sport of Pencak Silat.
- vii). To conduct Executive Committee Meeting /A.G.M. as per Constitution.

If the office bearers fail to perform the above mentioned activities, the Executive Committee can analyse the whole working & propose an appropriate action, which needs to be ratified by the General Body.

20 (b). For State Pencak Silat Associations / Union Territories:

- i). To organize District / State level competitions.
- ii). To organize Zonal/ Inter Zonal/ Invitational/ All India/ Federation Cup/ Beach Nationals / National level competitions with the approval from IPSF.
- iii). To prepare and send the teams for various competitions approved by Indian Pencak Silat Federation.
- iv). To conduct Coaching Camps at the respective state level for Sub Juniors, Junior & Senior in connection with preparation for participation in various competitions held in India.
- v). State Associations / Union Territories are required to comply with the rules and regulations laid down in the IPSF Constitution failing which they are liable to dis-affiliation. This include the various activities and obligations in the Constitution.
- vi). No office bearer of State Associations / Union Territories will go to the Press / any Outside Organization / any individual, and give comments about the activities of the Federation. Before going to the press they must have to give in writing their complaints/grievances to the Secretary General- IPSF, who in consultation with the President has to take appropriate action within 30 days. If needed, such complaints / grievances may be placed before the Executive Council Meeting of IPSF. In case of violation of any of the above, Executive Committee of IPSF have full right or can propose appropriate action including suspension of the concerned state unit. There will be a press & Publicity Committee, who will be constituted well before the said event and they will be authorize to connect with Media (print & electronic).



21. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a). The Federation will appoint National Coaches.
- b). The Federation will hold the Competitions, where feasible the under mentioned competitions annually. These competitions should be organized through District and the state competitions in each State, further leading to the competitions at the National Level.
- c). In all Competitions held under the banner of Indian Pencak Silat Federation, only IPSF approved equipment will be used & the approved dealer can supply the same accordingly.

22. DOPING RULES:-

Indian Pencak Silat Federation will be guided by the rules of International Pencak Silat Federation (PERSILAT) and amendments, if any, made to such rules from time to time. Indian Pencak Silat Federation also recognizes Sports Authority of India Dope Testing Laboratory for Domestic Competitions as well (if needed).

23. JURISDICTION OF THE FEDERATION :-

National Sports tribunal will have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters pertaining to the sports related disputes in accordance with the National Sports Governance Act, 2025.

For any other matter over which the National Sport Tribunal is not empowered under the National Sports Governance Act, 2025, the High Court (Kashmir) will have the exclusive jurisdiction in all such matters pertaining to the Indian Pencak Silat Federation, its activities and members.

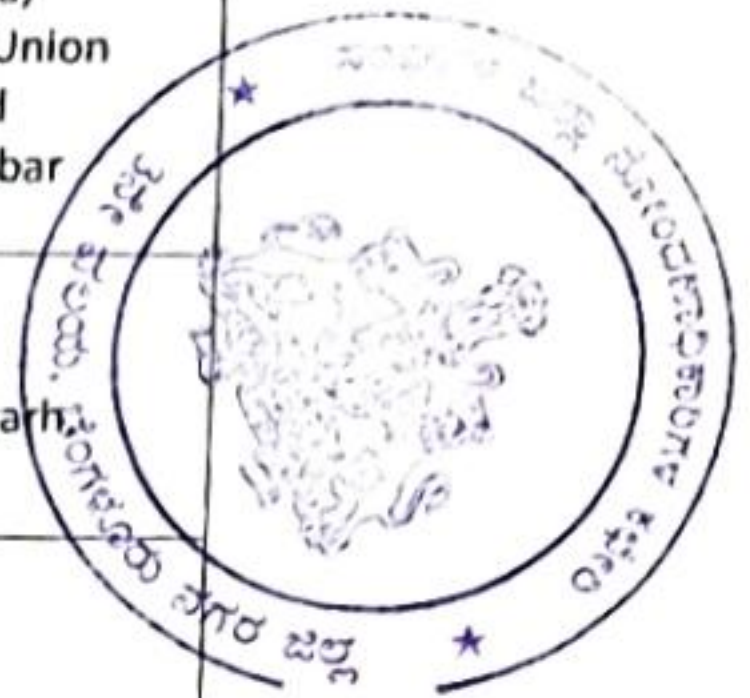

25. **DISSOLUTION:-**

- (i) The Association may be dissolved at a General Meeting, specially called for the purpose or upon requisition of 3/5th number of members, provided that 80% majority of members present, votes for the same.
- (ii) If upon the dissolution of the Association, there shall remain after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities and property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed amongst the members of the Association or any of them, but shall be given to some society on such terms and conditions to be determined by votes of not less than 80% of members present personally or in default thereof, as the appropriate Court of the Union Government may determine in that behalf.
